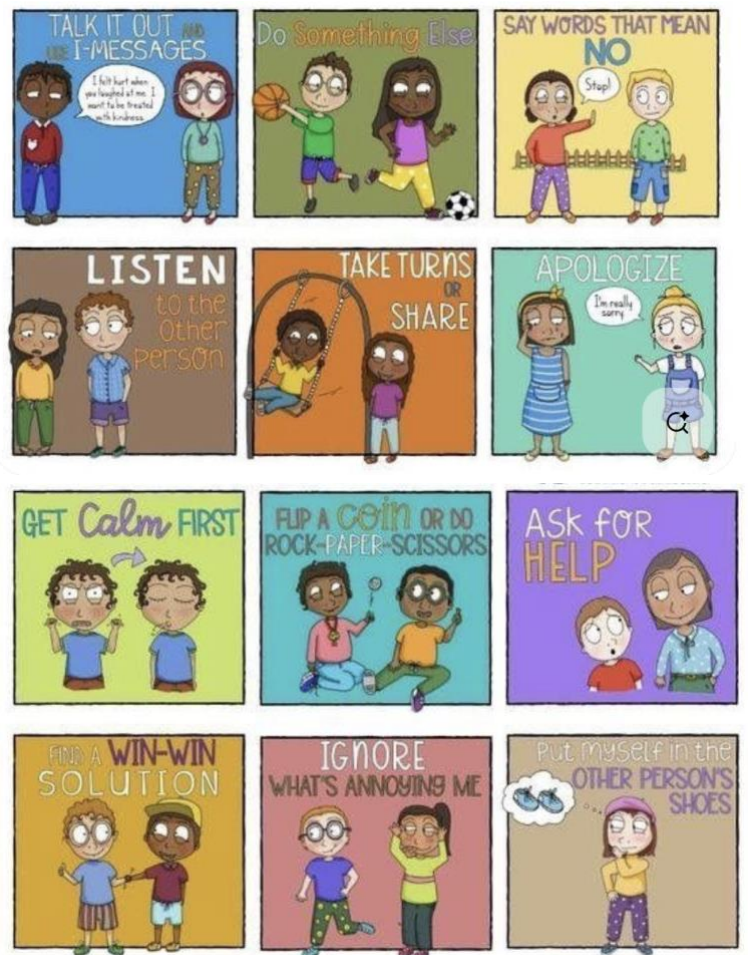

As part of our ongoing efforts to help students CARE for one another and show RESPECT, we've been learning how to manage strong emotions like anger and frustration in healthy ways.

At our assembly on Friday, we introduced a visual guide with simple strategies that students can use when they're feeling upset. These include techniques like deep breathing, counting to ten, using calm words, or finding a quiet space to cool down.

We encourage parents and caregivers to continue these conversations at home. When children hear consistent messages both at school and at home, it helps them feel supported and better equipped to handle their emotions with care and respect. Together, we can help our students grow into kind, thoughtful, and emotionally resilient individuals.

Monday September 29 is Orange Shirt Day, it is observed every year when we remember and learn about something that happened a long time ago in Canada. It’s about children who were taken away from their families and sent to schools called Residential Schools. These schools were not happy places. The children were not allowed to speak their own languages or celebrate their cultures. Many of them felt scared, lonely, and sad.

The day was inspired by Phyllis Webstad, a survivor whose orange shirt was taken from her on her first day at a residential school — a symbol of the loss of identity, culture, and dignity that so many Indigenous children experienced.

Monday is not just about wearing a color. It’s about listening, learning, and taking action. It’s about understanding the truth of our shared history and committing to reconciliation — in our schools, workplaces, and communities.

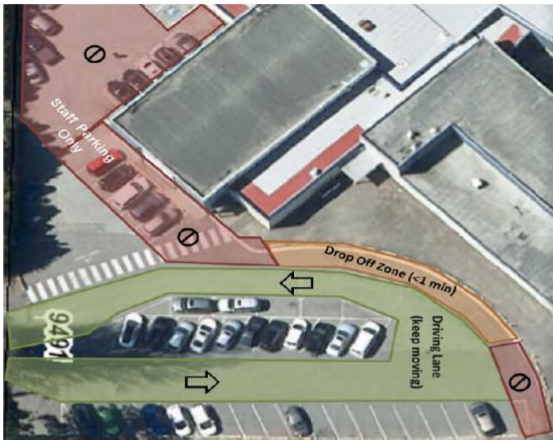

Reminder of school parking and drop-off guidelines

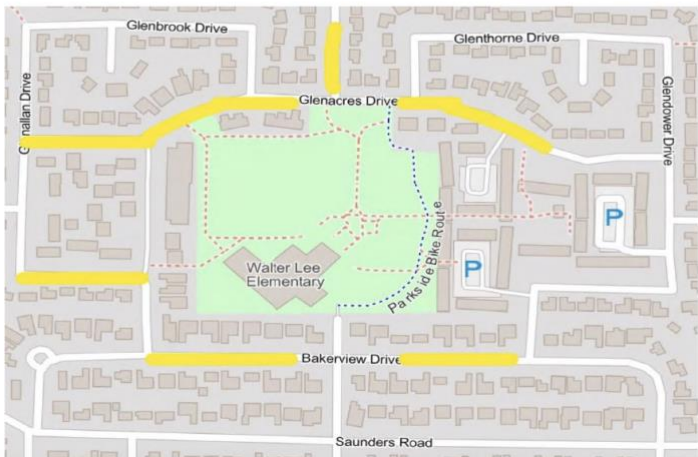
To ensure the safety of students please be aware of the guidelines and directions for our school parking lot.

LET’S KEEP OUR PARKING LOT SAFE FOR LEE STUDENTS & FAMILIES!
Our school parking lot gets extremely busy before and after school. For everyone’s safety, PLEASE FOLLOW these Parking Lot Safety reminders for safer traffic flow during these busy times.

PARKING LOT SAFETY REMINDERS

- ONLY PARK IN PARKING STALLS. Keep moving in the driving lane to avoid traffic jams.
- NO PARKING IN THE DROP OFF LANE or STAFF PARKING AREA. Only stop in the Drop Off Lane long enough for your child to get out/get into car - less than 1 minute.
- If you need to park and leave your car, PARK ON NEARBY STREETS. There is parking all around the school. Please see neighbourhood map.
- PLEASE SLOW DOWN and watch out for our students and families.
- KEEP THE CROSSWALKS CLEAR to ensure our students and families can cross safely.
