Pedalheads Promo Code - The PAC has once again partnered with Pedalheads (Swim, Bike, Soccer and Trail) to offer all of our Lee families a \$25 discount on programs and camps all while fundraising for our school! How it works: Simply log onto www.pedalheads.com/british-columbia and click "Find a Program" to explore their variety of bike, soccer, swim and trail programs offered. At the checkout screen, under "Payment Method" click on "Have a promo/coupon code?" and then enter **WALTERL26** to have \$25 automatically deducted from your total! Though this code **expires on June 30th, 2026**, you can register your children for camps in July and August using the code, you just have to register and apply the code before June 30th. The code is valid for all Pedalheads programs in BC.

Significant dates in our community

December 14–22, 2025 – Hanukkah (Jewish) To the Jewish students, staff, and families, we wish you a joyous Hanukkah filled with light, hope, and togetherness. As you light the menorah over eight nights, may this Festival of Lights bring warmth and happiness to your homes and hearts.
Translation note: Hanukkah (Hebrew: חנוכה) means “dedication” and commemorates the rededication of the Holy Temple in Jerusalem. Pronounced: KHAH-noo-kah or HAH-nuh-kah, depending on accent.

December 24, 2025 – Christmas Eve (Christian) Warm wishes to all who observe Christmas Eve. This evening is a time for reflection, anticipation, and gathering with loved ones. May your celebrations be filled with peace, kindness, and the spirit of giving.
Context note: For Christians, Christmas Eve marks the evening before the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ.

December 25, 2025 – Christmas Day (Christian) Merry Christmas to all who are celebrating! We send heartfelt wishes for a day of joy, hope, and connection. May this season bring warmth to your homes and remind us of the values of generosity, compassion, and peace.
