This week as I've walked around the school, most of our students and staff are still choosing to wear a mask; it continues to be a layer of protection that students and families can decided what is most comfortable based on personal preference. If your child requires a mask throughout the day, we have disposable masks available at school. We will continue to promote good hygiene practices such as staying home when ill and washing hands regularly.

As a staff, we have begun to organize and will hold more school-wide activities as permitted by the Ministry of Education and the Health Authority. We are excited to finally be able to engage our students in assemblies, drama performances and field trip experiences again. Please be assured that health and safety continue to be an important aspect that will guide us when planning and holding these events.

Just before Spring Break, the students really enjoyed a week of drumming instruction from "Milton Randall's Afro Drumming Experience." The drumming routines and songs echoed down the hallways for 5 days and it was such a great way to end term 2 with positive feelings.

On April 20th the Green Thumb Theater group will be performing "What If" at our assembly. We will be dividing the school's divisions in half to allow for sufficient spacing in the gym as the students watch a drama production about friendship and social responsibility.


