Take back your control.







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What's Inside?



Your Account: Your friends list, settings, username, email, avatar, connected accounts and any transaction history for Nitro. If you have created any developer applications, this will be included as well.
Your Servers: Servers you've joined. If you own a server, it will also include that server's icon, settings, roles, permissions, channels, audit log, and any custom emoji attached to it.
Your Messages: All messages you have sent in servers, DMs or group DMs. This folder will also include links to attachments uploaded.

Your Activity: Info about how you navigate the app, the times you used Discord, what games you played, and what servers you hung out in. We use this to improve Discord and tailor it to you. Your Programs: Any applications you have submitted for HypeSquad, Server Verification, the Partners Program, and other cool stuff.



- 6. The cloud logo means your child had the app.



Or **in the Android app,** tap on the three horizontal lines in the upper right corner of your main screen.

On the next screen, choose the icon that looks like a gear in the upper right corner.

Then under Preferences \rightarrow Media \rightarrow and select the option that says "Never Autoplay Videos."


Instagram







Click on your profile image in the lower right corner of your screen. Then from the upper right corner, tap on the three horizontal lines.



Go to Settings and privacy \rightarrow Suggested content \rightarrow Sensitive content.

Choose "Less" and Instagram will show fewer posts that it considers potentially sensitive. If you change this setting, you may still see graphic images from accounts that you follow.

TikTok








"Restricted Mode" helps limit graphic videos from the For You Page. You may also see a warning about "Sensitive content" and can choose to click to watch or skip the TikTok video.

Tap on your profile in the lower right corner. Then click on the three horizontal lines in the upper right.



Pick the option for Settings and privacy \rightarrow Content preferences \rightarrow Restricted Mode. You'll need to set a passcode to turn Restricted Mode on or off.

YouTube



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On Youtube.com: When a video is playing, hover your cursor to the bottom of the video. You'll see in the middle an auto play button with an image for pause. Click that to automatically stop playing one video after another.

YouTube has more instructions here. YouTube also said that in some cases, it may apply a warning to videos before they start playing.

Another option in **YouTube's iPhone and Android app:** Click on your profile in the upper right corner.



Choose Settings \rightarrow Autoplay. Tap off to stop one video from automatically playing when you finish another.

Another option: Settings \rightarrow General \rightarrow Restricted mode. Tap on to hide videos on that particular device that YouTube considers "potentially mature."



From the top left side of the screen, choose the image of your profile picture.

Choose Settings and Support \rightarrow Settings and privacy \rightarrow Privacy and safety \rightarrow Content you see.

Uncheck the box that says "Display media that may contain sensitive content."

Another option is to stop videos from playing automatically as you scroll.

From the top left side of the screen, choose the image of your profile picture.

Choose Settings and Support \rightarrow Settings and privacy \rightarrow Accessibility, display and languages \rightarrow Data usage \rightarrow Autoplay. Select "Never" to stop videos from playing automatically as you scroll.





WhatsApp



You can mute notifications for a WhatsApp group, which means you won't be alerted to new messages. You can resume notifications later if you choose. <u>WhatsApp has</u> <u>instructions here</u>.

You can also block individuals in your group chat or report material in the group to WhatsApp if you believe it is inappropriately violent or manipulated information. <u>Those</u> <u>instructions are here</u>.

Or you can <u>leave a WhatsApp group</u>. If you do so, only the administrators of that group chat are notified.

Helpful Tips On How to Have Tough Conversations

 Provide a safe space for them to share their feelings and concerns – listen and validate; fear, anger, confusion, worry, insecurity and other reactions are to be expected.

 Let their questions be the guide – do not share or expose them to unnecessary details; limit exposure to news and social media.

 It's okay to not have all the answers but to emphasize the importance of getting factual information and limiting exposure to misinformation.

 \cdot Provide general, brief facts with an emphasis on what adults and individuals can do to keep themselves and others safe.







How to Ensure we Co-Regulate and Not Co-Escalate

 \cdot Model being calm and in control. Children look to adults on how to react.

 \cdot Keep a schedule and routine. This provides a sense of predictability which can lessen anxieties.

 \cdot Engage with social support. Now is the time to support each other.

• Most importantly, remember the importance of your own selfcare, adults must also reach out for support.
