- If students are going to be dropped off by car, please enter the school at Door #8. This way students don't have to walk through the parking lot at the front of the school.

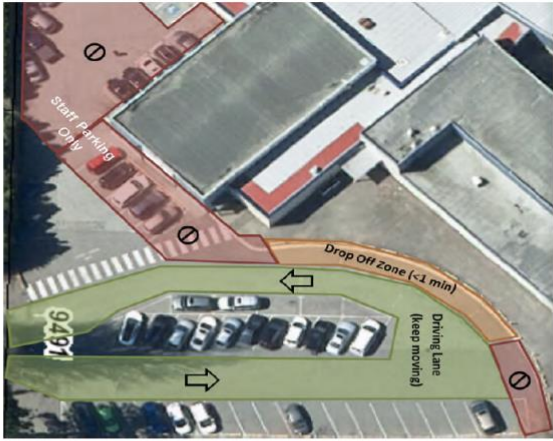
Coming in LATE?

Our school parking lot gets extremely busy before and after school. For everyone's safety,
PLEASE FOLLOW these Parking Lot Safety reminders for safer traffic flow during these busy times.

PARKING LOT SAFETY REMINDERS

- ONLY PARK IN PARKING STALLS. Keep moving in the driving lane to avoid traffic jams.
- NO PARKING IN THE DROP OFF LANE or STAFF PARKING AREA. Only stop in the Drop Off Lane long enough for your child to get out/get into car - less than 1 minute.
- If you need to park and leave your car, PARK ON NEARBY STREETS. There is parking all around the school. Please see neighbourhood map.
- PLEASE SLOW DOWN and watch out for our students and families.
- KEEP THE CROSSWALKS CLEAR to ensure our students and families can cross safely.

Significant dates in our community

November 5, 2025 – _Birthday of Guru Nanak Dev Sahib (Sikh)

We extend our heartfelt greetings to Sikh students, staff, and families as you celebrate the Gurburab (birth anniversary) of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, the founder of Sikhism. May this sacred day bring peace, wisdom, and inspiration to all.

Translation note: Gurburab combines Guru (teacher) and Burab (celebration/occasion), referring to a day that commemorates a Guru’s birth or significant life event.

Pronounced: GOOR-poo-rub

Guru Nanak Dev Ji (ਗੁਰੂ ਨਾਨਕ ਦੇਵ ਜੀ) is honoured as the first Sikh Guru and spiritual teacher.

6 Respect the non smoking environment of our schools and school district facilities.
