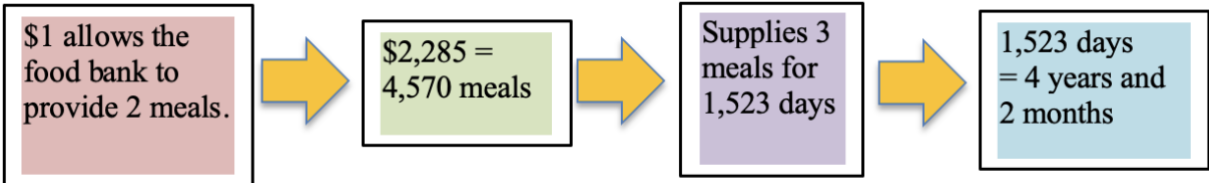
Downloading Term 1 Learning Update reports
